Applicants must be an excellent team player and have a skill set that applies to a collaborative and dynamic project based learning environment.

We are currently looking for an engaging and enthusiastic educator to join our teacher team beginning with our 2022-23 school year. The start date would be the last week of July, 2022. This position joins a small dedicated cadre of teachers who together are responsible for designing, planning and implementing a dynamic project-based curriculum that integrates language arts, math, science, social studies and electives. Some stand-alone course teaching is likely also needed/expected. Due to the small school nature, many additional responsibilities arise as the year progresses.

This full-time position requires flexibility, drive and excellent communication skills, and a curious mind with a willingness to constantly learn is required. Projects will often be physically demanding and could include hiking, ocean swimming, and intense gardening, etc. Therefore, applicants must be active and appreciate the outdoors. Experience in the science field would be most relevant, especially concerning the scientific method, environmental studies and sustainability, engineering principles and data analysis. Applicants must be willing to spend the majority of their time outdoors in a hot humid environment working on year-long projects alongside students. The school's focus is to allow students to lead while teachers facilitate clear and guided direction and mentoring on project goals within the framework of the team structure. A working knowledge of google docs and sheets is preferred.
